**CAMPUS CLEANLINESS POLICY**

As members of the Miami Palmetto Senior High School community, students play a major role in promoting and maintaining a campus environment which is free of litter and debris. With the understanding that recent budget cuts have resulted in a 25% decrease in custodial staff, students now more than ever, play a large part in campus cleanliness.

Effective immediately, please be advised of the following:

- All classrooms are to free of litter. Prior to the end of class all paper/litter should be picked up from the floor and placed in a trash receptacle.
- Student locker rooms are to be free of litter. Prior to the end of class all paper/litter should be picked up from the floor and placed in a trash receptacle.
- Students eating in the cafeteria, the Pawvillion, or in areas where picnic tables are located are to place their trays/garbage in trash receptacles before leaving the area.
- Students will not consume food in hallways at anytime during the day. This includes during breakfast, lunch shifts, and passing. Hallways will be closed to student traffic during both lunch shifts. Students must have a signed official hall pass in their possession in order to gain access to a secured hallway.
- Students will report the existence of graffiti to a custodian, teacher, or administrator.
- Students will report restrooms in need of cleanup or supplies to a custodian, teacher, or administrator.
- Students utilizing parking lots are to place their garbage in trash receptacles before leaving the area.
- The athletic field is considered an outside classroom. Prior to the end of class all paper/litter should be picked up from the ground and placed in a trash receptacle.
